

The Children of Camp Kirk Fund

Lions Clubs Camp Kirk Foundation opened for campers in 1993 with 32 campers attending. In 2016 we were at full capacity of 144 campers and a waiting list. We have come a long way.

The cost involved in sending a child to Camp Kirk for two weeks is over \$3,000.00, of which the parents are asked to pay 50%.

In 1994 the Lioness District President Mary Peters initiated this fund as her annual project raising \$47,000.00. Since then other Lioness District Presidents and Governors have also raised funds for this project. We also receive generous donations from our A-16 Lion and Lioness Clubs and individuals.

This fund is to supplement the cost of camp that some parents cannot afford. Since 1995, the fund has paid an average of \$6-8,000 annually, with over \$130,000 donated to assist with the cost for deserving children to attend.

About the Camp

Lions Clubs Camp Kirk Foundation (LCKKF) is a non-profit organization located just east of the Village of Kirkfield, Ontario on Highway 48. The 100 acre property is owned, built and maintained by Lions and Lioness clubs in District A-16.

The camp consists of 22 buildings: a dining hall, a washroom building including laundry facilities, a Camp Director's cabin, a nursing/administration office, an arts and crafts building, a science building, 14 sleeping cabins, a maintenance building and a swimming pool, along with a recreational building.

The first camping season was in 1993 with 32 campers. Since 2001 the camp has operated at its capacity of 144 campers per season.

The camp property is available for use before and after the summer season by groups who are carefully selected and sponsored by a Lions/ Lioness/Lions Clubs in our District.

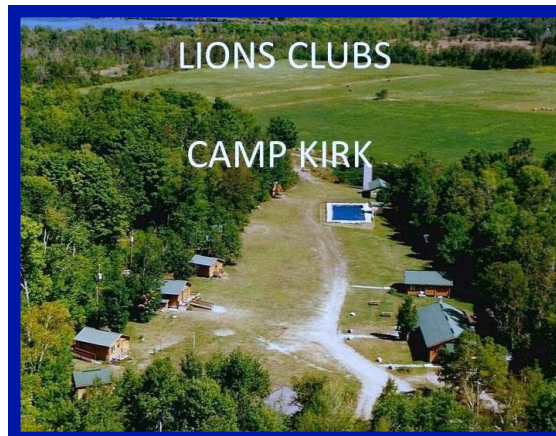
